



Public Comments

Be it resolved that the Municipality of the District of Yarmouth;

- **allow 15 minutes at each Regular Council Meeting and Committee of the Whole Meeting for a public comment session, prior to the adjournment of the meeting.**

Further, be it resolved;

- **that each citizen be allotted a maximum of 3 minutes to present their comments, within the 15-minute time allotted for the public comment session;**
- **that comments be within the purview of municipal government;**
- **that comments be directed to the whole of Council and not to individual Councillors or staff;**
- **that questions be directed to Council via written correspondence as the public comment session is not intended as a Q&A between members of the public and Council. Rather, it is an opportunity for a community member to voice their position on an issue of interest to municipal government;**
- **that the public comment session agenda item be included on a trial basis until the end of the present Council's current term;**

AND

- **that the list of citizens slated for the public comment session be determined by the Chair of the meeting by a method of their choosing.**
