

Periodically, the Nova Scotia Utility and Review Board (UARB) requires the Municipalities to conduct reviews of their municipal polling districts and the number of councillors. The hearing for the Municipality of Yarmouth Polling District Review was on March 19, 2015 and the decision to approve was made on March 27, 2015. These district boundaries became official on Nov. 23, 2016, at the time of the first meeting of the new council after the 2016 election. These same boundaries are current for the 2020 elections.
