

Town of Yarmouth Recreation Assets Report

Parks:

Broad brook Park

Broad brook Park is a 25 acre site owned by the Town of Yarmouth. The Civic address is 2 Clements Avenue. Development of the park started in 1993 with the construction of the access road and Veterans and Mariners baseball fields. Travelers field was built on the southern end of the park around 1994.

A maintenance/service building was constructed in 1998. This building houses a small maintenance shed, canteen, meeting room and washrooms.

A wetland trail linking South East St, Albert St, Forest St and Clements Ave was completed in 2013. The trail serves to protect a valuable wetland while providing an active transportation route throughout the park.

The Yarmouth Dog Park was established in 2019 to provide dog owners and those who care for dogs, the opportunity to socialize and provide their pets with off-leash exercise. It is centrally located within the park, accessible from the Broad Brook Trail.

Gateway Park

Historic Gateway Park is located on the corner of William Street and South East Street in Yarmouth. This was the long-time home to the famed Yarmouth Gateways. The legendary Boston Red Sox once visited the field for an exhibition game.

Gateway Park is suitable for senior Baseball on the Gateway Ball field and Minor baseball on the St Ambrose ball field. There are canteen and washroom facilities on-site at the maintenance shed. The Park also boasts a 400m dirt running track.

Coronation Park (Formerly Milton Ball field)

Coronation Field is located in Milton, in a historic section of Main Street Yarmouth in the North end of the Town.

Coronation Field is what a community field should be. It's quaint, easy to get to, and used all the time by the surrounding neighborhood. Yarmouth Minor Baseball also uses it for its minor baseball house league program. There is an outdoor adult fitness station located there as well.

St Ambrose Baseball Field - minor baseball (190’ R field, 210’ L field, 240’ center field)

Travellers Baseball field - minor baseball (200’ R field, 225 L field, 240’ center field)

Veterans Baseball field- regulation baseball (320’ R field, 320’ L field, 400’ center field)

Mariners Baseball field- minor baseball/softball (260’ R field, 260’ L field, 315’ center field)

Milton Baseball field- minor baseball

Yarmouth Elementary Soccer field 94mx52m

Yarmouth High School soccer field 100m x 70m

Lake Milo Aquatic Club

The Lake Milo Boat Club is located at 700 Main Street on the shore of Lake Milo and on the border with the Municipality of the District of Yarmouth. It is a 2 storey, wood frame construction, built in 1937.

For over 80 years, the Milo Boat Club has been the focal point for aquatic activities on the lake by residents of the Town and Municipality. In its early years, hundreds of spectators attended swimming and boating events at the club. Today, the Boat Club and Lake Milo remain very popular for aquatic and other recreation activities.
