The Vial of Life program assists emergency personnel in obtaining important medical facts during a crisis in the home



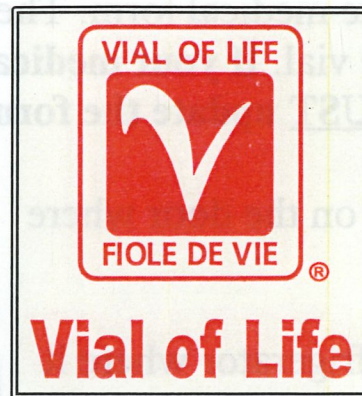
Who Should use the Vial of Life?

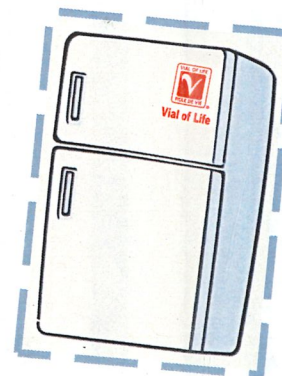

Information on the Vial of Life:

Why use the Vial of Life?

- ★ Request your Vial of Life from the Yarmouth County Senior Safety Program: (902) 881-4099, **if you require assistance in completing the Vial of Life forms please contact the Senior Safety Coordinator.**
- ★ Decide whom you will ask to be your emergency contact. This person would be contacted in case of an emergency.
- ★ Each individual must fill out a separate medical form. The completed form(s) must then be placed inside the vial. **If your medications or medical information changes you MUST update the form.**
- ★ Place your vial inside the refrigerator, on the door where you keep your condiments.
- ★ Place the Vial of Life sticker on the refrigerator where it can be easily seen (top right or left hand corner)



Medical emergencies can happen to anyone at any time. If an emergency or crisis occurs in the home it is vital that emergency personnel such as paramedics, police & fire fighters are able to utilize your medical information immediately to provide the best treatment possible.
